Water Safety Programme

Prior to the holiday break, please complete and return permission forms for 3-6 Swimming programme, which is due to start on day 1 of Term 2.

As Prep to 2s will not be doing the programme until Week 3 of Term 2, we will send their permission forms home after the holidays.

Parents are reminded that students should come to school in their PE Uniform during this two week programme. Swimming caps are available from the school office for \$3.00. **Please note that wearing swimming caps is compulsory.**

Naplan Testing

Naplan Testing will take place in Week 3 of Term 2 for all students in Grades 3 and 5 again this year.

Part of the data collected refers to parental education and occupation groups. Parents of Grades 3 and 5 students would today have received a Parental Background Validation form to update these details.

Late in 2016 we moved to a new version of our Student Records and some information may have been lost in the transfer. Therefore, we ask that you please check the details on these forms, make any necessary adjustments and return to the school office as soon as possible.

Emergency Practice

Early next term we will hold an unannounced emergency practice with staff and students, to test our response to a potential scenario that staff identify a threat warranting the school go into lockdown (opposite to evacuation).

Winter Uniform Changeover

When we return from the school holidays, students will be required to be in full Winter uniform. Winter uniform will be worn in Terms 2 and 3, returning to Summer uniform in Term 4. In accordance with our Sunsmart Policy, it is not a requirement to wear hats with the Winter uniform. This is due to the reduced UV index during the Winter months in Tasmania.
