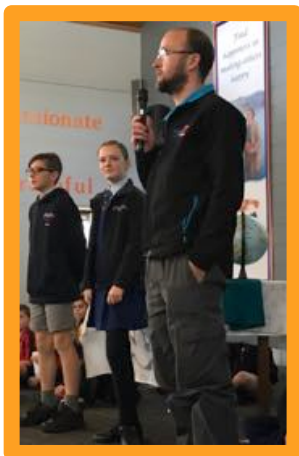

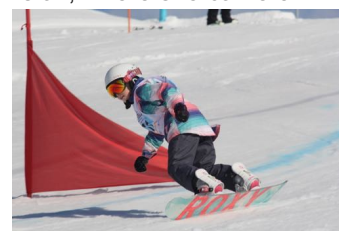

The Labs will be held in the Devonport Christian School B Block on Wednesday afternoons between 3.30pm and 5.00pm. The Term 4 Design and Robotics Labs will be held from 25 October to 15 November (4 weeks). Students will need to choose a STEM project to pursue during the 4 weeks and design a self-lead project. The cost for Term 4 is \$40.00. Scholarships are available.

Invoices will be sent to successful applicants. All fees are due prior to the commencement of the first lab on 25 October 2017.

Applications must be submitted by 7.00 pm on Wednesday October 18. Places are limited. Successful applicants will be notified by Friday 20 October.
