When it comes to instilling a love of reading, it doesn't really matter what you read. The important thing is that we all help to inspire our children to feel confident and comfortable reading.

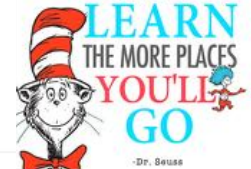
Students are enjoying reading to their buddies in our new 'Buddy reading program,' this important time allows students to develop positive relationships and build on their skills of reading and comprehension.
